How to apply...

- Visit the JIE website at www.jiejamaica.org and download our Membership Prospectus.
- Select and complete the appropriate application form.
- Prepare all supporting documentation (typically your Degree Certificate, a Curriculum Vitae showing your Engineering experience, and your company's organizational chart. If applicable, it is also advised to submit your PERB Certificate of Registration.
- Depending on your membership class, your application must be supported by JIE members in good standing:
 - For Graduate Membership at minimum, one (1) Corporate Member
 - For Corporate Membership two (2) Corporate Members
 - For Affiliate Membership two (2) Corporate Members
 - For Student Membership at minimum, one (1) Corporate Member along with Head of Department

Your application "supporters" will verify and attest to the credibility of the copies of your supporting documentation and your experience as an Engineer. Alternatively, a JP may verify copies of your supporting documents.

- Submit your application form and supporting documents. This may be done one of two ways:

 - 2. You may drop of your documents at the JIE office at 9 Leinster Road, Kingston 5
